While this phenomenon also occurs in primary schools, it is more characteristic at the kindergarten and secondary levels. In the case of Hungarian Roma students enrolled in Slovak-medium secondary classes, it may even be considered typical that some children are kept in the education system “on paper” for as long as possible (due to institution financing reasons).
